## ③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

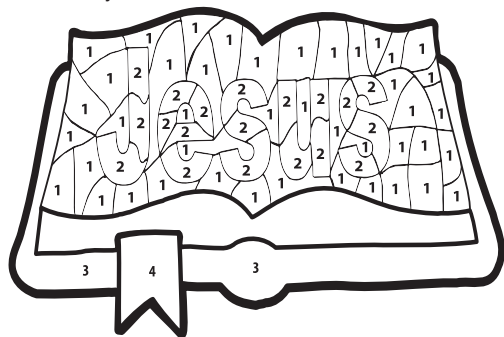
Ask God to help you see and understand more things about Him as you read the Bible and as you learn your memory verses.

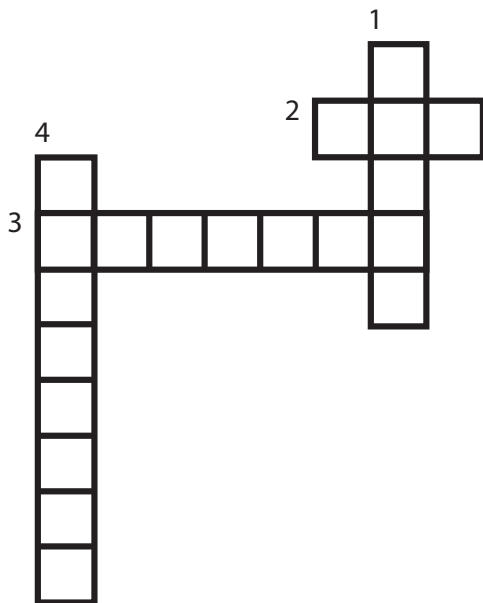
Color the spaces by number.

# Quiet Time

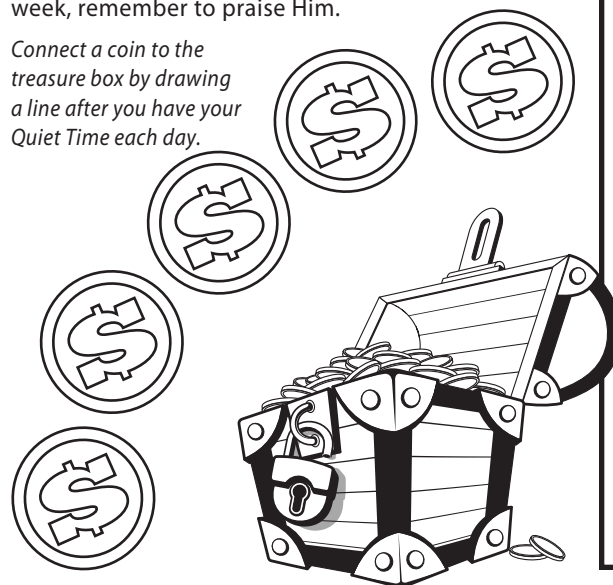
As you have your Quiet Time each day, be sure to read and think about this week's memory verse. It has a wonderful promise in it!

**1 READ ABOUT IT!**

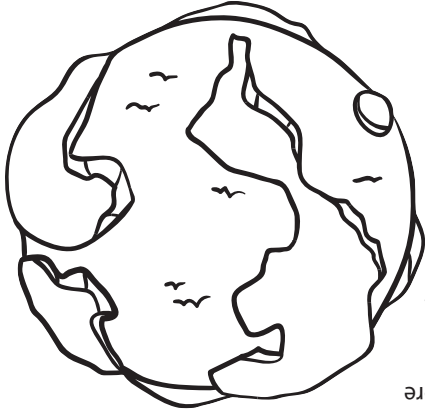
"He [Jesus] is the

**2 THINK ABOUT IT!**

Propitiation—now that is a big word! Here is how  
to say it: pro-pit-she-a-shun. It means that Jesus did  
what God required so you could be saved. If you have  
believed in Jesus, He took your punishment for sin.  
He didn't run out of power to save after He took your  
sins. He has the power to save everyone in the world  
who believes in Him no matter who  
they are or where  
they live.

**3 PRAY ABOUT IT!**

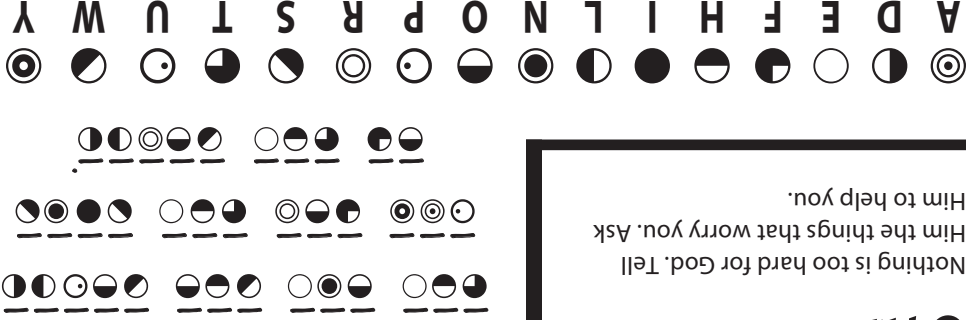
Nothing is too hard for God. Tell
